**SUMMARY:**

**Overview:**

Over the past several years, the County's Department of Planning and Land Use (DPLU) has been undergoing business process reengineering. While the Department has made great strides, we believe that more can be done with the help of an independent task force. This Board Letter authorizes the establishment of a task force of land use experts to focus special attention on the business side of operations at DPLU.

**Recommendations**

**CHAIRMAN HORN AND VICE CHAIRMAN ROBERTS:**

1. In accordance with Board Policy A-74, Citizen Participation in County Boards, Commissions and Committees, direct the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) to return to the Board within 30 days with a resolution establishing the Red Tape Reduction Task Force.
2. Direct the CAO to assess the County costs of supporting the task force, identify a funding source and return with a recommendation in 30 days.

**BACKGROUND:**



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
